about Explanation Text

There will be time when you want to tell someone how or why something occurs. Your science teacher might ask you to tell how pollution affects the environment. Your little brother might ask you why some birds sleep along the winter. Talking or writing about how or why something happens is called Explanation. The purpose of an explanation text is to tell each step of the process (the how) and give reasons (the why)

FEATURES OF EXPLANATION TEXT

Constructing an Explanation Text

The steps of constructing an explanation text are :

1. General statement : A general statement about the event or phenomena
2. Sequence of explanations : a series of paragraphs that tell the hows or whys
3. Closing : a concluding paragraph that sums up what has been learnt

Language features in explanation text

The language features usually found in explanation text are :

1. The use of terms related to the topic (technical terms)
2. The use of present tense
3. The use of passive voice
