Alokasi Waktu : 6 x 40 menit

Tujuan Pembelajaran:

Melalui pembelajaran berbasis *discovery based learning*, peserta didik dapat *mengidentifikasi tata bahasa, menggunakan dan membuat kalimat sederhana* dengan *menggunakan bahasa yang benar* dan *santun* dengan menunjukkan sikap *percaya diri, kerjasama dan bertanggung jawab*.

Langkah-Langkah Pembelajaran

Pertemuan 1

Peserta didik:

1. mengobservasi powerpoint dan gambar;
2. mencatat beberapa hal penting dalam gambar;
3. mencari arti kata / rujukan menggunakan kamus (buku ataupun online);

Pertemuan 2

Peserta didik:

4. menghubungkan informasi yang ada untuk membuat kesimpulan;
5. mengerjakan quiz;

Pertemuan 3

Peserta didik:

6. membuat kalimat berdasarkan gambar;
7. mengunggah hasil kerja di WhatsApp grup, saling memberi umpan balik;
8. merevisi hasil kerja yang telah dibuat berdasarkan umpan balik dari teman sekelas dan guru;
9. Mengunggah hasil kerja bagian di laman sosial media sekolah.

Penilaian

- Pengetahuan : Membuat satu paragraf menggunakan kalimat berbentuk present perfect tense
- Keterampilan : Menjelaskan struktur kalimat berbentuk present perfect tense
- Sikap : Menunjukkan kesantunan, percaya diri, kerjasama, dan tanggung jawab

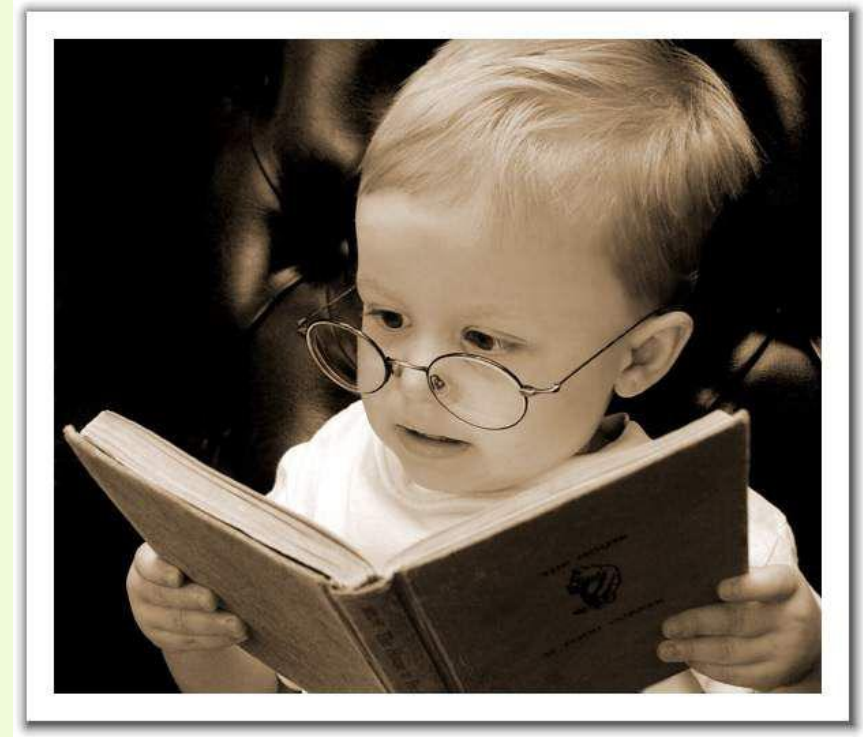

I **have lost** the chess game.

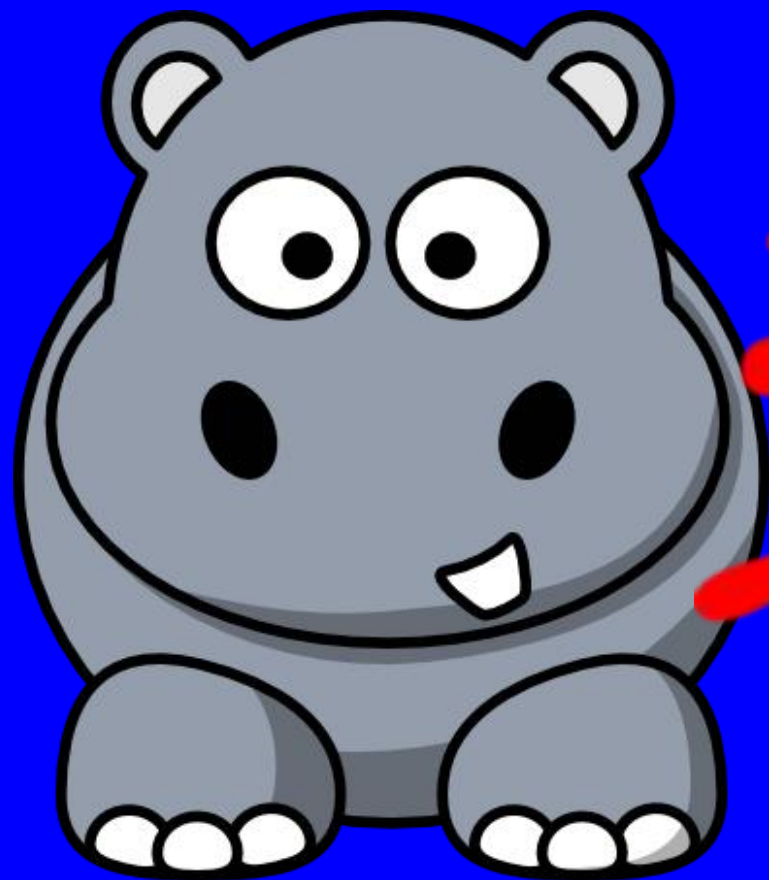


Teach – taught – **taught**
