C. Materi Pokok

Sturktur Teks Narrative

- 1. *Orientation* merupakan paragraf pembuka teks yang mengenalkan siapa tokoh yang terlibat dalam kejadian (*who*) serta latar waktu (*when*) dan tempat yang melatar belakangi kejadian (*where*).
- 2. **Complication**, memaparkan krisis yang terjadi terhadap tokoh utama. Complication terdiri dari menjelaskan paragraf yang awal Awal masalah masalah. ini juga mengawali rentetan plot (alur cerita) yang kemudian akan berlanjut pada konflik, klimaks, dan anti klimaks cerita.
- 3. **Resolution**, krisis berakhir dengan baik atau dengan tidak baik bagi tokoh yang juga merupakan akhir cerita. Resolution adalah paragraf yang menjadi akhir cerita. Dalam bagian ini, terjadi penyelesaian yang membuat jalan cerita berakhir. Setiap permasalahan yang muncul harus ada penyelesaiannya, bisa ditutup dengan akhir yang menyenangkan (*happy ending*) atau berakhir tragis atau menyedihkan (*sad ending*).
- 4. **Reorientasi**, memberikan alasan atau komentar umum, opsional. *Reorientation* merupakan kalimat penutup yang menceritakan kondisi terakhir sang tokoh dalam cerita atau pesan moral cerita. Oh iya, bagian ini tidak wajib ada pada *narrative text*, ya!
