b) <i>Peserta didik melakukan diskusi secara klasikal tentang, nama minuman dan cara membuatnya.</i> <i>Peserta didik menyaksikan video cara membuat minuman seperti gambar yang diperlihatkan, sambil menjawab pertanyaan-pertanyaan tentang isi video tersebut.</i> <i>Peserta didik membahas jawaban pertanyaan-pertanyaan tersebut in turn secara klasikal.</i>	20'	Prememori

WHAT IS PROCEDURE TEXT?

- Definition
procedure text is a text containing of a series of steps/instructions to make or to do something.
- Purpose/Aim
procedure text has function **to critic/procedure the events or art works for the reader or listener, such as movies, shows, book, and others.**
- Generic Structure

GOAL	the product / aim / goal we want / get/ produce after doing the steps/instructions
MATERIALS	Equipments / Materials needed to be prepared.

	- tool - mainstay - materials - ingredients or seasoning
STEPS/INSTRUCTION	a set of instruction or what we must have to do / make something, usually in sequence

- Language Features
 1. It uses imperatives, modals, simple present, or passive voice (dominated by imperatives)
 2. It includes technical terms, like first, second, firstly, secondly, next, then, finally, etc.
 3. It uses words that tell the reader how, when, and where to perform the task.
