- ✓ Mengungkapkan pesan moral yang terdapat dalam bacaan folkrole “Malin Kundang” dengan tepat

a. Pendekatan : Scientific Approach (Pendekatan Sainifik)

b. Langkah-Langkah Pembelajaran ;

Kegiatan Pendahuluan (15 Menit)	
Melakukan pembukaan dengan salam pembuka dan berdoa untuk memulai pembelajaran, memeriksa kehadiran peserta didik sebagai sikap disiplin	
Mengaitkan materi pembelajaran yang akan dilakukan dengan pengalaman peserta didik dengan materi sebelumnya serta mengajukan pertanyaan untuk mengingat dan menghubungkan dengan materi pembelajaran yang akan disampaikan.	
Menyampaikan motivasi tentang apa yang dapat diperoleh (tujuan & manfaat) mempelajari materi : <i>Bacaan naratif folklores</i>	
Menjelaskan hal-hal yang akan dipelajari, kompetensi yang akan dicapai, serta metode belajar yang akan ditempuh,	
Kegiatan Inti (40 Menit)	
Kegiatan Literasi	Peserta didik diberi motivasi dan panduan untuk melihat, mengamati, serta membaca bahan bacaan dengan pemahaman terkait materi <i>bacaan Folklore Sangkuriang</i> .
Critical Thinking	Peserta Didik diminta untuk mengidentifikasi sebanyak mungkin hal yang belum dipahami melalui pertanyaan-pertanyaan yang berhubungan dengan materi <i>bacaan Folklore Sangkuriang</i> .

Collaboration	Peserta didik diminta membentuk kelompok untuk mendiskusikan, mengumpulkan informasi, mempresentasikan ulang, dan saling bertukar informasi mengenai <i>bacaan Folklore Sangkuriang</i> .
Communication	Peserta didik diminta untuk mempresentasikan hasil kerja kelompoknya dan memberikan kesempatan kepada kelompok lain untuk menanggapi, kemudian memberikan jawaban atas tanggapan dari kelompok lain tersebut.
Creativity	Guru dan peserta didik bersama-sama melakukan Refleksi tentang hal-hal yang telah dipelajari terkait <i>bacaan Folklore Sangkuriang</i> . Kemudian Peserta didik diberi kesempatan untuk menanyakan kembali hal-hal yang masih belum dapat dipahami
Kegiatan Penutup (15 Menit)	
Guru dan Peserta didik bersama-sama membuat rangkuman/simpulan pelajaran tentang poin-poin penting yang muncul dalam kegiatan pembelajaran yang telah dilakukan.	
Guru menutup kegiatan pembelajaran dan memberikan tugas/PR terhadap peserta didik
