## Graph or Chart

A picture, so they say, will tell a thousand words. But what about a graph or chart? A good graph or chart can show as much as several paragraphs of words. But how do you choose which style of graph to use? There are several different types of charts and graphs. The four most common are probably line graphs, bar graphs and histograms, pie charts, and Cartesian graphs. They are generally used for, and are best for, quite different things.

You would use:

- Bar graphs to show numbers that are independent of each other. Example data might include things like the number of people who preferred each of Chinese takeaways, Indian takeaways and fish and chips.
- Pie charts to show you how a whole is divided into different parts. You might, for example, want to show how a budget had been spent on different items in a particular year.
- Line graphs show you how numbers have changed over time. They are used when you have data that are connected, and to show trends, for example, average night-time temperature in each month of the year.
- Cartesian graphs have numbers on both axes, which therefore allow you to show how changes in one thing affect another. These are widely used in mathematics, and particularly in Algebra.

## 2. READING COMPREHENSION

A caption, also known as a cutline, is a text that appears below an image. Most captions draw attention to something in the image that is not obvious, such as its relevance to the text. Captions can consist of a few words of description, or several sentences. Along with the title, lead, and section headings, captions are the most commonly read words in an article, so they should be succinct and informative. Captions also include a short title or heading of an article in a magazine or newspaper. Words shown on a cinema or television screen to establish the scene of a story are also called captions. Captions can also be inserted below/above charts, figures, graphics and tables. There are several criteria for a good caption. A good caption clearly identifies the subject
of the picture without detailing the obvious. It is succinct. It establishes the picture's relevance to the article, provides context for the picture, and draws the reader into the article.

## Simple Present Tense

The simple present tense is one of several forms of present tense in English. It is used to describe habits, unchanging situations, general truths, and fixed arrangements. The simple present tense is simple to form. Just use the base form of the verb: (I take, you take, we take, they take) The 3rd person singular takes an -s at the end. (he takes, she takes)

## The simple present tense is used:

- To express habits, general truths, repeated actions or unchanging situations, emotions and wishes:

I smoke (habit); I work in London (unchanging situation); London is a large city (general truth)

- To give instructions or directions:

You walk for two hundred meters, then you turn left.

- To express fixed arrangements, present or future:

Your exam starts at 09.00

- To express future time, after some conjunctions: after, when, before, as soon as, until: He'll give it to you when you come next Saturday.

Be careful! The simple present is not used to express actions happening now.

## Examples:

- For habits

He drinks tea at breakfast.
They watch television regularly.

- For repeated actions or events

We catch the bus every morning.
It rains every afternoon in the hot season.
They drive to Monaco every summer.

- For general truths

Water freezes at zero degrees.
The Earth revolves around the Sun.
Her mother is Peruvian.

- For instructions or directions

Open the packet and pour the contents into hot water.
You take the No. 6 bus to Watney and then the No. 10 to Bedford.

- For fixed arrangements

His mother arrives tomorrow.
Our holiday starts on the 26th March

- With future constructions

She'll see you before she leaves.
We'll give it to her when she arrives.

## Notes on the simple present, third person singular

In the third person singular the verb always ends in -s:
he wants, she needs, he gives, she thinks.

Negative and question forms use DOES (= the third person of the auxiliary 'DO') + the infinitive of the verb.

He wants ice cream. Does he want strawberry? He does not want vanilla.

Verbs ending in -y : the third person changes the -y to -ies:
fly --> flies, cry --> cries
Exception: if there is a vowel before the -y :
play --> plays, pray --> prays

Add -es to verbs ending in:-ss, -x , -sh, -ch:
he passes, she catches, he fixes, it pushes

When building a sentence in English, a verb is always required. The verb "be" is the most important verb to learn in English. "TO BE" is used to describe objects, features, locations, etc. The verb " TO BE "has three forms in the present; am, is and are.

## Graph or Chart

A picture, so they say, will tell a thousand words. But what about a graph or chart? A good graph or chart can show as much as several paragraphs of words. But how do you choose which style of graph to use? There are several different types of charts and graphs. The four most common are probably line graphs, bar graphs and histograms, pie charts, and Cartesian graphs. They are generally used for, and are best for, quite different things.

You would use:

- Bar graphs to show numbers that are independent of each other. Example data might include things like the number of people who preferred each of Chinese takeaways, Indian takeaways and fish and chips.
- Pie charts to show you how a whole is divided into different parts. You might, for example, want to show how a budget had been spent on different items in a particular year.
- Line graphs show you how numbers have changed over time. They are used when you have data that are connected, and to show trends, for example, average night-time temperature in each month of the year.
- Cartesian graphs have numbers on both axes, which therefore allow you to show how changes in one thing affect another. These are widely used in mathematics, and particularly in Algebra.

## Simple Present Tense

The simple present tense is one of several forms of present tense in English. It is used to describe habits, unchanging situations, general truths, and fixed arrangements. The simple present tense is simple to form. Just use the base form of the verb: (I take, you take, we take, they take) The 3rd person singular takes an -s at the end. (he takes, she takes)

## The simple present tense is used:

- To express habits, general truths, repeated actions or unchanging situations, emotions and wishes:

I smoke (habit); I work in London (unchanging situation); London is a large city (general truth)

- To give instructions or directions:

You walk for two hundred meters, then you turn left.

- To express fixed arrangements, present or future:

Your exam starts at 09.00

- To express future time, after some conjunctions: after, when, before, as soon as, until: He'll give it to you when you come next Saturday.

Be careful! The simple present is not used to express actions happening now.

Examples:

- For habits

He drinks tea at breakfast.
They watch television regularly.

- For repeated actions or events

We catch the bus every morning.
It rains every afternoon in the hot season.
They drive to Monaco every summer.

- For general truths

Water freezes at zero degrees.
The Earth revolves around the Sun.
Her mother is Peruvian.

- For instructions or directions

Open the packet and pour the contents into hot water.
You take the No. 6 bus to Watney and then the No. 10 to Bedford.

- For fixed arrangements

His mother arrives tomorrow.
Our holiday starts on the 26th March

- With future constructions

She'll see you before she leaves.
We'll give it to her when she arrives.

## Forming the simple present tense: to think

## Notes on the simple present, third person singular

In the third person singular the verb always ends in -s:
he wants, she needs, he gives, she thinks.

Negative and question forms use DOES (= the third person of the auxiliary 'DO') + the infinitive of the verb.

He wants ice cream. Does he want strawberry? He does not want vanilla.

Verbs ending in -y : the third person changes the -y to -ies:
fly --> flies, cry --> cries
Exception: if there is a vowel before the -y :
play --> plays, pray --> prays

Add -es to verbs ending in:-ss, $-\mathrm{x},-\mathrm{sh},-\mathrm{ch}$ :
he passes, she catches, he fixes, it pushes

When building a sentence in English, a verb is always required. The verb "be" is the most important verb to learn in English. "TO BE" is used to describe objects, features, locations, etc. The verb " TO BE "has three forms in the present; am, is and are.

One of the biggest mistake retailers make is to open up accounts on every social media platform they think is relevant and then (11) $\qquad$ (leave/leaves) them alone with no activity.
