



WAYS TO LINK CAUSES AND EFFECT



Effect Cause

A tsunami generally occurs <u>because</u> a tectonic plate on one side of a fault sinks suddenly during an earthquake.

Cause Effect

The land absorbs heat from the sun. <u>Therefore</u>, the air above it becomes hot. The air above the land becomes hot. <u>Consequently</u>, the heated air expands and rises. The heated air expands and rises. <u>As a result</u>, an area of lowpressure forms over the land.
